gambling mechanisms

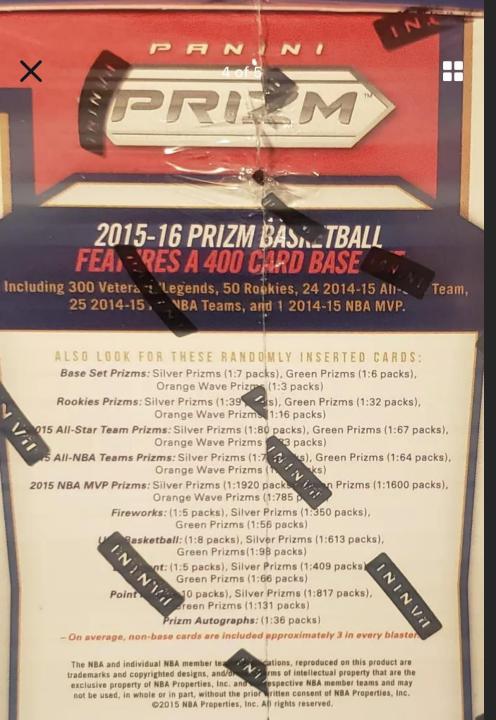
Loot boxes generate

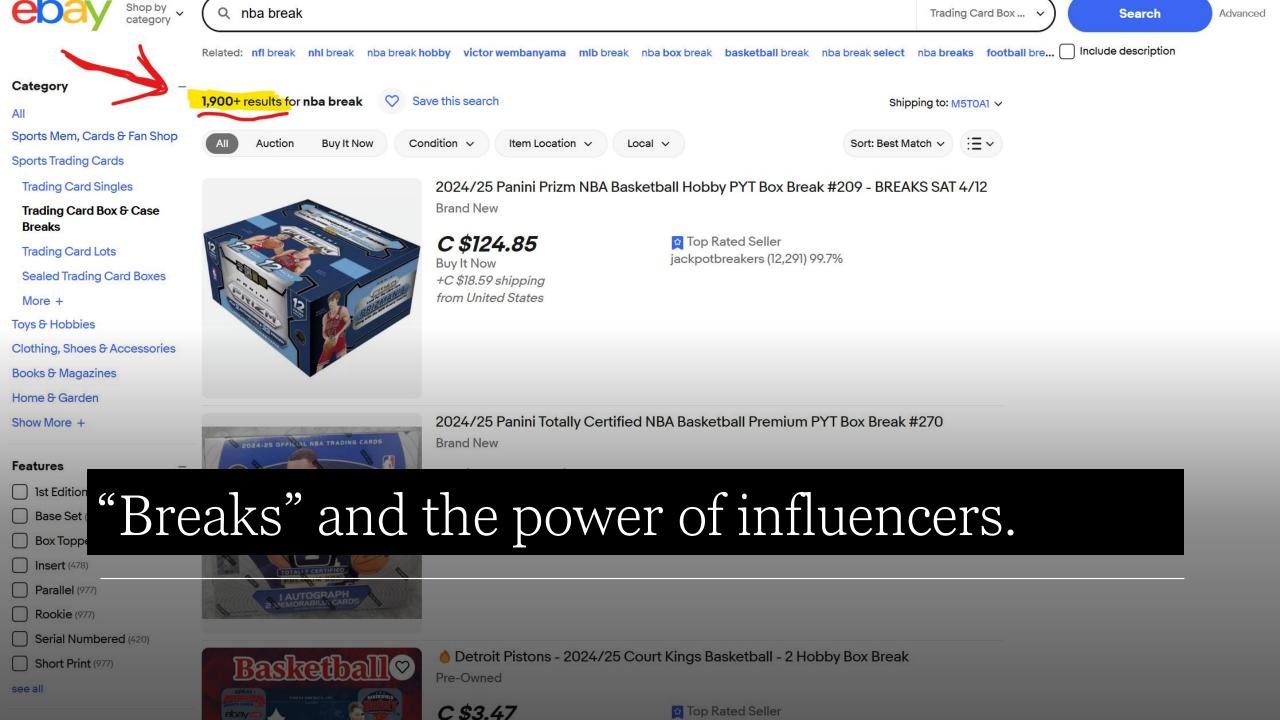






Average odds aren't always clear.
